Swachhata Day & SASA Initiative – “MonSoon Hygiene” Awareness and Cleanliness Activities

In compliance with the instructions cited in the references above, our institution conducted various awareness and cleanliness activities under the August 2025 monthly theme of **"Mon-Soon Hygiene"** on **23-08-2025 (4th Saturday)** as part of the **Swachhata Day** and **SASA (Swachha Andhra – Swarna Andhra)** program.





The following activities were organized:

1. Awareness Poster Release:

- The Principal, **Dr. Y. Sreelatha**, formally released a poster titled “**Mosquito-Borne Diseases: Stay Alert During Monsoon – Prevent Breeding, Stay Safe**” to raise awareness on waterborne and vector-borne diseases during the monsoon.

2. Expert Awareness Session:

- **Dr. V. Sandhya**, Head of the Department of Zoology, and **Dr. M. Vijaya Kumar**, Faculty, Dept. of Zoology, addressed the students and faculty on the **common mosquito breeding grounds** and **precautionary measures** to prevent mosquito-borne diseases during the monsoon.

3. Health Awareness Session by Community Health Department:

- Staff from the **Community Health Department, Atapaka (Kaikaluru)** gave a detailed talk on:
 - **Seasonal communicable diseases** during monsoon.
 - **Importance of hygiene**, personal sanitation, and environmental cleanliness.

4. Cleanliness & Drainage Drive:

- NSS volunteers, under the guidance of **NSS Coordinator Dr. M. Vijaya Kumar**, carried out a **drain cleanup** around the college campus.



- Coordination was made with **local municipal authorities** to clean external drainage points.

5. Mosquito Breeding Prevention Measures:

- Inspection for **stagnant water** in and around campus was carried out.
- **Larvae breeding sources were removed**, and awareness was created among students regarding household-level practices.

6. Awareness Material Distribution:

- **Pamphlets** on monsoon hygiene and prevention of vector-borne diseases were distributed to students and nearby community residents.

7. Student Participation:

- Volunteers from **NSS and Eco Club** actively participated in the awareness activities, cleanup drives, and poster exhibition.

The activities were successfully carried out with active participation from faculty, students, and support from community health officials. The event helped reinforce the importance of hygiene and community health during the monsoon season, aligning with the objectives of the SASA initiative.
